PALS no-kill animal shelter is the *only* shelter in Lincoln County. PALS and the amazing animals we care for, thank our generous donors and volunteers for our success in 2016. Provided a safe haven and shelter for almost **400** abused, stray, abandoned, or owner-surrendered dogs and cats.



294 homeless dogs and cats found homes with their forever families.



100 donors and **38** sponsors made generous contributions to the welfare of the shelter



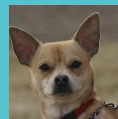
300 volunteers generously donated **11,680** hours to provide care to the shelter animals until they were adopted.
